

Three Lakes Village Pool Rules

To ensure a safe and clean pool for all our community, please follow the general pool rules.

- No admission without Three Lakes Village Pool Pass. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult 18 years of age.
- Residents will be responsible for the behavior of their guest; guest must be accompanied by a resident from the same address.
- If the guest's behavior results in expulsion from the pool the accompanying resident will also be expelled. All ID's will be confiscated and returned will be based on a review by the board.
- No diving, running or rough play. Lifeguards will ask offenders to leave the pool.
- No glass containers or alcoholic beverages allowed within the fence area.
- Only small floating items allowed. The Manager/lifeguard has the discretion of what items will be allowed.
- No pets allowed inside fence.
- Proper swimming attire required. No cut-off shorts.
- Lifeguards are not responsible for supervision of the of the baby pool. Parents are responsible for children in the baby pool.
- The lifeguards will take a ten minute rest period each hour. If only one guard is on duty everyone will exit the pool during the break. If there are two lifeguards all swimmers under the age 18 will need to exit the pool.
- No swimming allowed except for hours when lifeguards are present.
- No loud music around the pool area and no plug-in appliances allowed.
- No cocoa butter, baby oil or other heavy lotions allowed. They cause equipment problems.
